## 1. WTO negotiations: International Meeting of GI Producers on June 10th and 11th, 2003 in Geneva

Hundreds of producers from over twenty countries converged on Geneva June 10th and 11th, 2003 to demand improved protection for geographical indications. The assembly was spearheaded by the Federal Institute of Intellectual Property, the Swiss association for the promotion of AOC's and GI's, French and Italian producers, and diverse Member States of the WTO (see Institute p! ress release from June 4, 2003 in F, G, and I). It was important for the producers to make their difficulties in getting sufficient protection for GI's known to the international press before the next ministerial conference, which will be held in September 2003 in Cancun, Mexico. They also wanted to send a strong message to the highest levels in the WTO and WIPO (see the press release from oriGIn from June 11, 2003). This rally led producers to adopt a declaration (see link below) demanding better international protection for! geographical indications and to the creation of an international network for the producers to further their cause. The network organization has been named ori**GI**n (*Organisation for an International Geographical Indications Network*).
