5. Court Judgment in Document Falsification Case

The criminal court in Chaux-de-Fonds sentenced a man on June 13, 2003 to 6 months prison because of document falsification. The accused falsified Institute documents with the intension of making a business partner believe that he had registered ten trademarks in the partner's name and that the partner thus owed him a large amount of money. The partner notified the Institute of this and the Institute decided to privately file suit against the man as well. The Institute is clearly against such activities as they damage the Institute's reputation and go against the best interests of customers. It will file criminal ch! arges whenever it learns of a case of document falsification. There is a similar case pending before a court in another canton at the moment.
