## 1. The new copyright act: highway or dead-end?

## 2. Singapore Treaty on the Law of Trademarks (Singapore TLT)

On March 28 2006, the Singapore Treaty on the Law of Trademarks was signed. The Singapore TLT allows Swiss trademark applicants easier access to trademark protection at foreign trademark offices through its more efficient and user-friendly administrative procedures as well as its broader area of applicability. Thus it also makes it possible to lower the costs for international trademark protection.
