## 1. The Council of States approves the revision of the copyright act

19.12.2006. The Council of States, in its role as the foremost legislative body, gave its approval to amend the legislative message to ratify two World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) treaties and the partial revision of the copyright act. It adhered to the majority of the Committee for Legal Affairs in all points and subsequently followed the Federal Council with few exceptions. (Debates in German/French:

## 2. National Council approves patent law revision

20.12.2006. The National Council, in its role as premier legislative body, gave its approval to amend the patent law and passed the patent law treaty (including the execution regulations) in a vote of 110 against 51 with 25 abstentions. It adhered to the majority of the Committee for Legal Affairs in all points and subsequently followed the Federal Council with few exceptions. (Debates in German/French:
