1. Federal Patent Court regulations published

The various regulations organising and administering the Federal Patent Court, enacted by the court administration under PatCA, Article 20, para 3. letter a, have been published on the homepage of the Federal Patent Court as of early October: <http://www.bpatger.ch/en/legal-basis.html>

The regulations take effect on 1 January 2012 and will be part of the official compilation of federal law. Two guidelines, one on proceedings before the Federal Patent Court and the other on the court's autonomy, are published separately.
